Epigraph

[French: Épigraphe]

An epigraph marks a quotation(s) placed at the beginning of a publication or a chapter.

If an epigraph comes at the very start of the work, provide the section with the title **Epigraph** and mark the title with a **Heading 1**. If an epigraph comes before a chapter (usually between the chapter title and text), it does not need a heading.

Use the **Blockquote (DAISY) style** to identify each quotation. Use the **Author (DAISY)** or **Citation (DAISY)** style to identify the author of the quotation, depending on what is applicable.
