# Textboxes & Sidebars



UNDER CONSTRUCTION

Text boxes, sidebars, and asides are all what are considered secondary content.

All secondary content should be moved to an appropriate place within the main narrative flow (i.e. at the end of a paragraph or section.)



Farrah: Should we have them move the secondary content to the end of the section? Or if it is in the middle of a section should we separate it by asterisks?

The appropriate heading level is to be applied to the heading of the secondary content. For more information, please see the [Headings Section](#).

You will need to add the term **Aside:** to all secondary content headings. This will indicate to the reader they are reading secondary content.



If the secondary content does not have a heading insert the heading **Aside** with the appropriated heading level

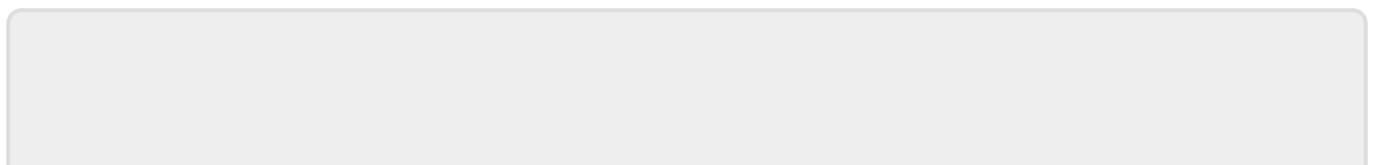
